Leave A303 at the Weyhill Junction (A342) and after crossing A303, take second exit at large roundabout across the face of the Premier Hotel towards Ludgershall. Around. ½ mile turn right into Short Lane (marked Pentons) and continue into Harroway Lane and to the T junction, turn right in to Foxcotte Lane and after ¾ mile turn left - which is still Foxcotte, at the next roundabout go straight across into the ground.

Driving to the Ground



Take the M6 to just after Junction 5 and merge on to the M42 At junction 3A, exit onto M40 toward London/ Warwick/ Stratford then at junction 9, take the A41/A34 exit to Bicester/ Aylesbury/ Oxford/ Newbury.

At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto A34 then just before Winchester At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto the M3 ramp to Southampton/ Bournemouth/ Portsmouth and merge on to the M3 then just before Southampton keep to the left hand side and take the M27 after 20 mile just after Portsmouth take the exit for the A27, then take a right after a mile on to the B2149/A3023 exit toward Havant/ Hayling Island into Havant.

At the Hayling Island roundabout, follow the road through the town centre crossing three sets of traffic lights until you go over the railway and come to a roundabout. Go straight on, through another three sets of lights. At the fourth, just past the Elf garage, turn right into Bartons Road.

The ground will be on your right. At the top of the hill immediately after a pedestrian crossing, turn right into Martin Road. The entrance to the ground is several hundred yards along the road on your right.

From North East

From the M25 take junction 10 on to the A3, follow the A3 southwards until it becomes the A3. Just after it does take the B2149 turning, signposted to Emsworth, at the top of the slip road turn left, follow the road to a small roundabout and turn right. Continue along this road into Rowlands Castle and you'll be confronted by a small double roundabout.

Go straight over the first and right at the second, taking the road running down the righthand side of the Shell petrol station. Follow this road round until it becomes a dual carriageway. At the first set of traffic lights turn left into Bartons Road. The ground will be on your right. At the top of the hill immediately after a pedestrian crossing, turn right into Martin Road. The entrance to the ground is several hundred yards along the road on your right.

After half a mile the road eventually comes to a dead end by a junction onto a dual carriageway, cross the road and walk along the right-hand side of the dual carriageway (this is pavement, the route runs along a housing estate), continue up to the next set of traffic lights, just before a petrol station and opposite the Heron pub, and looking right you should see a dead-end road and the ground's floodlights. Turn into the road and the ground entrance is a hundred yards on the left.
