

On entering the outskirts of Kidderminster, turn left at the traffic lights at the junction with the A449, by the Land Oak Public House then turn right at the next lights and go towards the town centre, passing the Severn Valley Railway Station on your left. Turn left at the roundabout take the first exit and the next take the second exit follow signs for Stourport on Severn (A451). On entering the outskirts of Stourport, follow one-way system to Town Centre.



Take the M6 to junction 12. Take A5 until the roundabout just outside Brownhills (next roundabout after the Turn pub on the left). Take A452 Chester Road North through Brownhills High Street to traffic lights at Shire Oak (pub at junction on right hand side). Turn right on to A461 for Walsall, go to next set of traffic lights, cross over and turn right immediately on to Oak Park Leisure Centre car park (rear of Kentucky Fried Chicken). Go diagonally over car park and follow road round to ground entrance.



Using the M5/M6 motorways take the M5 North past junction 1 on to M6 north. Leave at junction 9 (Wednesbury turn off) and then take the A4148 to Walsall. Go for about 2 miles over several roundabouts until going down a hill alongside the Arboretum. At big roundabout at the bottom, turn right onto A461 for Lichfield. Take A461 for about 4 miles and go through Walsall Wood village (after Barons Court Hotel on right), up the hill after village, Oak Park is on the left opposite the Fitness First, turn left and go diagonally across Oak Park Leisure Centre car park, follow road round to the ground entrance.





The M5/M6 alternative is to take the M5 North and bear left after junction 1 (West Bromwich) onto M6 south. 



Train to **Wolverhampton Railway Station** and then walk down to the bottom of Railway Drive and turn right and walk up the Ring Road, then take the first into Wednesfield Road and at the bus stop take the Chaserider 71 bus to Park Lane walk back and turn left, then left into Brook lane walk up to the Swan Pub then turn right into Walsall Road then take a left for Little Wryley into Hazel Lane and the ground is on the left after a few yards.
