

Take the M6 and then join the A14 then exit the A14 at Junction 14 for Bedford and Kettering and at the roundabout take the third exit and at the next take the first onto the A6 then go straight on at the next seven roundabouts at the eight take the third exit onto Newton Road and then take the first right after Newton Road School on the right (if you pass it you have missed it) and the ground is on the left after 100 yards.



South

Take the M1 to junction 13 and at the first roundabout take the second exit and second exit at the next onto the A421 and then keep on the left lane and join the A428/A6 then at the lights take a left onto the A428 Branston Way then go straight on at the next two roundabouts then at the third take the first exit then go straight on at the next then take the second exit at the next roundabout on the A4280.

Continue on this road and at the next exit join the A6 Great Ouse Way then second exit at the next roundabout then straight on at the next and then first exit at the next roundabout onto the A6. Then go straight on at the next roundabout then first exit at the next onto Newton Road and then take the first right after Newton Road School on the right (if you pass it you have missed it) and the ground is on the left after 100 yards.

Exit the M1 at junction 22 for Leicester & Coalville and take the fourth exit onto Little Shaw Lane then take the first exit at the next roundabout then do a left then first right into Wood Road into Nailstone and there it becomes the Main Road and follow the road left after the village and at the T Junction take a left onto Hinckley Road then after about six miles take a left for Barwell at the end of the road take a left into Kirby Road and the ground is on the right take the sign for the Cricket & Football club and park beside the cricket ground.



South

Take junction 20 of the M1 for Barwell and take the Lutterworth Road and at the next roundabout take the fourth exit onto the A5 then take a right after around five miles onto Lutterworth Road and then at the T Junction take a left onto Burbage Road and then continue onto the traffic signals turn right onto Leicester Road and at roundabout take the second exit onto The Common and in the village centre straight over at mini roundabout and then turn right into Kirby Road and the ground is 400 metres on the right and park beside the cricket club.

Driving to the Ground



Take the M1 to junction 26 Kimberley and from the South take the exit at the roundabout and from the North take the first exit and take the A610 and at the next roundabout fourth exit at Nuthall junction and then first exit at Cinderhill roundabout and at the next Baghall take the third exit onto Baghall Road and go straight on at the next two roundabouts and then take the second on the left into Greenwich Lane and the ground is in front of you after 50 yards.



From M1 Junction 26

Follow A610 to Nottingham for 1.3 miles, passing over one roundabout and turn left at the second roundabout onto Cinderhill Road following signpost to Bulwell. After a quarter of mile turn right into Bagnall Road, and a further half a mile turn left into Greenwich Avenue, the entrance to the ground is straight ahead.



From the north - A60

Entering Nottingham via the A60, turn right onto the B6004 Oxclose Lane (signposted to Basford). After 2.2 miles, pass over the level crossing and continue onto David Lane. After a quarter of a mile turn right onto Bagnall Road and a further quarter of a mile turn right into Greenwich Avenue, the entrance to the ground is straight ahead.



From the south - A52

Entering Nottingham via the A52, continue along the Ring Road A6514 following signs to Mansfield for approximately two miles, until the junction with the A610 is reached. Turn left onto the A610 (signposted to M1). After 1,000 yards turn right onto Stockhill Lane (B6004) and then continue along Stockhill Lane for a third of a mile, turning left at the mini



roundabout into Mill Street and then turning left into Bagnall Road. After a quarter of a mile turn right into Greenwich Avenue, the entrance to the ground is straight ahead.

Train to **Nottingham Railway Station** is by tram. Leave the station following the signs to the tram stop at Station Street and take it to the David Lane Tram Stop beside Vernon Park then walk a few yards and turn left into Mill Road and walk up to Curry Nights and Mc T Pizza and then turn left into Bagnell Road and walk up to Greenwich Road then take a right and walk down to the ground.



Train to **Bulwell Railway Station** is the closest to the ground make your way to Basford either by tram or bus. If you walk out to the bus stop and take the **79a Nottingham Transport** to Headstocks and then wait a few minutes and get the **70 Nottingham Transport** to Greenwich Avenue on Bagnell Road and turn left its 2 minutes to the ground on the left.

Take the M1 take junction 23 and take the A511 to Junction 23 for Coalville and at the roundabout take the second exit onto Ashby Road and go through three roundabouts and at the crossroads just before the library take right into Belvoir Road passing the New Inn on you left turn right past Da Vinci's into Jackson Street past the bus stop and the next right into Owen Street the ground is on the left past the houses when you come to a lane with a row of trees turn left up this lane past the cricket field the ground is at the end of Kane Lane.

South & North West

From M42/A42 take exit 13 (Signposted Ashby) and at the roundabout take the fifth exit follow A511 to Coalville and go through three roundabouts and at the Library crossroads take a into Belvoir Road passing the New Inn on you left turn right past Da Vinci's into Jackson Street past the bus stop and the next right into Owen Street the ground is on the left past the houses when you come to a lane with a row of trees turn left up this lane past the cricket field the ground is at the end of Kane Lane.

The club moved to Keys Park in 1995, after leaving their former Cross Keys ground, where they had been playing since 1903. The purpose built Keys Park has on one side of the stadium is the Main Stand and this single tiered stand, is raised above pitch level and has 710 seats and roughly is half the length of the pitch in size, straddling the halfway line. There are small portions of open terrace to either side and at the back of the stand are some hospitality areas.



Behind one goal at the Hednesford End is a small covered seated stand, which has a capacity of 300. Although situated directly behind the goal it doesn't extend to the full width of the end, having open terracing to one side towards the Main Stand.

The other two sides of the ground are similar sized terraces. When first built they were open to the elements but have since had roofs erected over them. There is also a small club shop, located at one corner within the ground (in-between the Main Stand and Hednesford End), that offers a good selection of programmes from local clubs.

If segregation is in force then up to 900 away fans are mostly housed in the Hednesford End which has a mixture of covered seating and open terrace and in addition open terrace to one side of the Main Stand is also allocated.

Driving to the Ground



Take the M6 to junction 11 take the A460 exit to M6 Toll/ Cannock from the North take the first exit from the south take the Third Exit and follow the A460 through to the seventh roundabout at the Texaco Station take the third exit onto Hemlock Way and after 800 yards take the second exit at the roundabout into Keys Parks Road and go up the hill and at the next roundabout take the third exit which takes you straight to the ground and there is plenty of parking round the ground.

There are two bars inside the stadium, which are located upstairs above the Main Stand, which welcome away fans. Normally only one of these is open to fans on match days. However, if segregation is in force then both bars are open.

Otherwise there is the Cross Keys Hotel which is about ten minutes' walk away at 42 Hill Street. This pub is listed in the CAMRA Good Beer Guide and has up to eight real ales on tap the connection to the Club goes further as the former Cross Keys football ground was located at the rear of the premises and was the pub you went to before the match at the old ground.

In 2007 Nuneaton Borough moved from their former Manor Park home to the then called Liberty Way stadium, after spending 90 years at their former Manor Park home. The Club went into liquidation in 2008 and were subsequently reformed as Nuneaton Town.

The stadium itself although new, is largely open three sides of the stadium are comprised of terracing, whilst the remaining side is the UK Flooring Direct Main Stand. This Main Stand is all seated and houses 514 supporters. It runs for around a quarter of the length of the pitch and has a floodlight pylon to either side.

Opposite is an open terrace, which has the Rugby Clubhouse situated at the back of it. At one end is the Britannia Tyres Stand a covered terrace, which is the home end of the ground. This stand can hold up to 1,800 fans and unusually the terracing is comprised of metal ones instead. The Stuarts Plumbing Stand is a similar looking covered terrace, but is smaller in size. In one corner of the stadium in-between the Stuart Plumbing Stand and South Terrace is a Security Control Box which has a clock mounted next to it. The ground is shared with Nuneaton Rugby Club.


